MONTENEGRO, BOSNIA HERZEGOVINA & CROATIA

Sunday 13 - Sunday 20 May 2018

CROATIA

We will explore the largely medieval city of **Dubrovnik** where visits will include the Franciscan monastery, the Baroque Cathedral and the Rector's Palace. Our morning of visits in Split, home to a number of cultural monuments, will include, the Palace of the Emperor Diocletian, who became Roman Emperor at the age of 29 and moved here in 303 AD. We will also visit the archaeological ruins at **Salona**, the town of **Trogir**, set within medieval walls on a tiny island, and **Sibenik**, whose cathedral is considered one of the finest architectural monuments on the Dalmatian coast.

MONTENEGRO

This small state gained its independence in 2006 after a short period in an alliance with neighbouring Serbia, and the entire region has a distinctly Balkan feel. We will travel to the fortified town of **Kotor** and the former Montenegrin capital of **Cetinje** where visits will include the National Museum of Montenegro, the Montenegrin Art Gallery and St Nikola's Museum.

BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

We will travel to the reconstructed Bosnian city of **Mostar**, in the south of the country where we will visit the iconic bridge in the Old City and the Koski Mehmed Pasa Mosque, a simple Mosque dating from the early 1600s. We will also visit **Blagaj Tekija** a 600 year old monastery housing dervish monks, which enjoys a stunning location at the base of a cliff alongside the River Buna.
